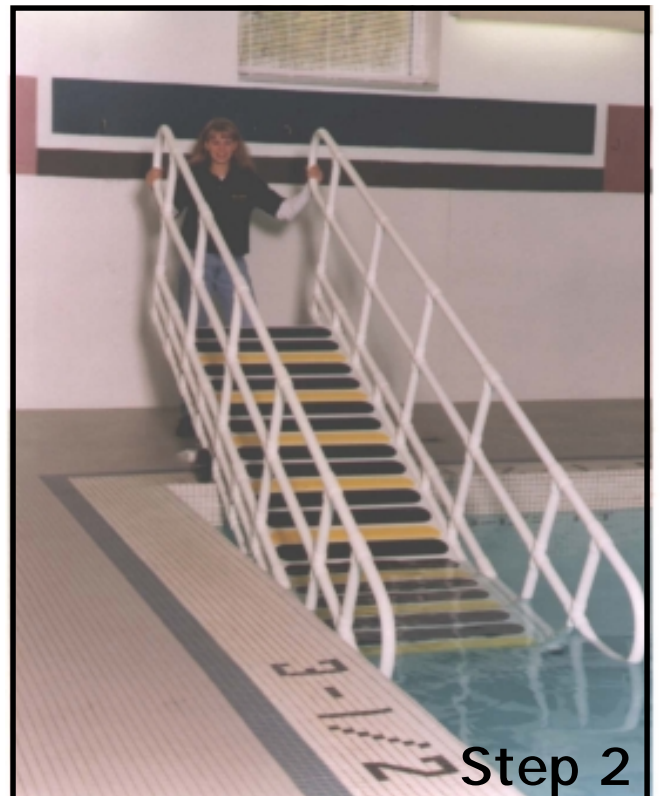

**Step 1**

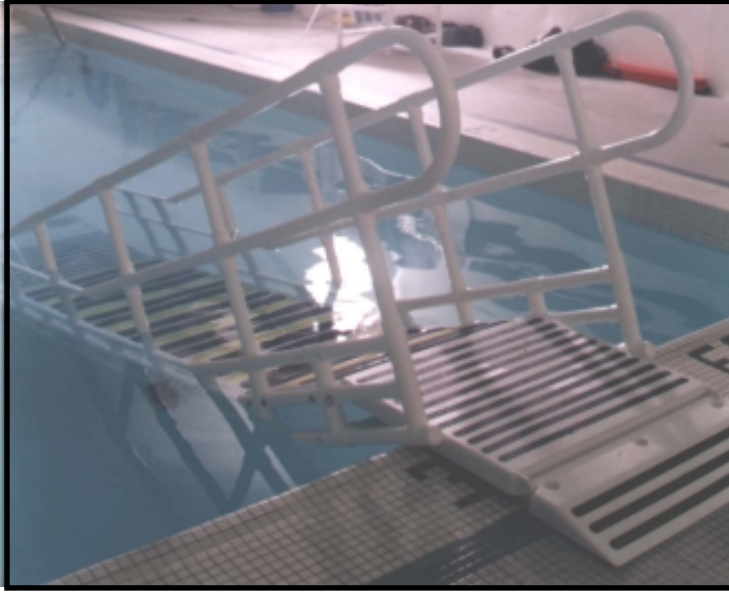
